ORDINANCE NO. 88-1

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING COUNTY WHEEL TAX

Commissioner Hendrick introduced the following ordinance:

BE IT ORDAINED by Butte County, in accordance with SDCL 32-5A, that a county tax be imposed on all automobiles, motor trucks, motorcycles, house trailers, trailer coaches, cabin trailers, and all other motor vehicles as defined in SDCL 32-3-1, registered in the county at a rate not to exceed two (2) dollars per vehicle wheel. The tax shall be administered and collected by the county. The per vehicle wheel rate shall be the same for all types of motor vehicles and the total vehicle tax may not exceed eight (8) dollars per vehicle. The proceeds from the tax shall be retained by the county, deposited in a special highway fund, and the revenue may be used only for highway and bridge maintenance and construction. The Board of County Commissioners shall, by resolution, establish a means of distributing the revenue generated by the wheel tax among the municipalities and townships located within the county. This ordinance will become effective on the twentieth day after its completed publication. That implementation of the Butte County Wheel Tax shall commence January 1, 1989.
