

POLICY TO REGULATE CONSTRUCTION WORK THAT IMPACTS BUTTE COUNTY ROADS

Be it in the best interest of Butte County that all persons, partnerships or corporations, which intend to do construction work that will impact the County's roads, shall first secure a permit from the Butte County Highway Superintendent. In applying for the permit, the construction contractor shall:

1. Notify the Butte County Highway Superintendent which road will be utilized by the company and the type of construction equipment.
2. Make provisions for restoring the roads back to their former equal to or better conditions.
3. Make provisions for controlling dust during the construction project.
4. Shall insure that all types of pipe or cable installed underground shall be buried at least eight feet from the driving portion of the road.
5. Shall insure that all markers identifying all pipe or cable is placed at least eight feet from the driving portion of the road.
6. Shall insure that all overhead lines across county roads must comply with state law.
7. They shall not trench through or cut any hard surface road without prior approval of the Highway Superintendent.
8. Provisions shall be made for allowance of variances within the discretion of the Highway Superintendent, who may require as a condition of any variance, the posting of a performance bond.
